HERE TO HELP AUSTRALIANS IN THE US

The Houston Consulate provides consular and passport services to clients across the jurisdiction of Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas and Louisiana.

The Consulate is led by the Australian Trade and Investment Commission (Austrade), reflecting the focus on trade and investment, particularly with Houston being widely regarded as the global energy capital. Benson Saulo is Australia's Consul-General and Senior Trade and Investment Commissioner to Houston. Texas.

Austrade is responsible for promoting Australian trade, investment and education to the world. In the US, Austrade services are primarily focussed on attracting direct investment into Australia to the betterment of the Australian economy and creation of jobs. In Houston, Austrade also focusses on seeking out opportunities for Australian companies in Texas' high potential sectors of energy, health and digitech.

Passports

Whether you are renewing your passport or applying for the first time, you will need to prepare an application form and submit it in person by appointment at our offices. Please refer to our <u>passport website</u> for instructions to guide you through the process and help ensure your passport application is complete.

Consular Services

Consular Services are provided to Australian citizens living or traveling in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas and Louisiana. The Australian Government will do all it can to assist Australians in difficulty overseas, but there can be legal and practical constraints as to the level of assistance which can be provided.

The <u>Consular Services Charter</u> provides a high-level overview and information on consular services. If you require consular assistance during regular business hours, please call our office on 832 962 8420. For consular emergencies outside business hours contact the Consular Emergency Centre in Canberra on +61 2 6261 3305.

Australian Visas and Australian Citizenship

For information on applying for a visa to visit Australia, Australian citizenship, eligibility requirements, dual citizenship and how to obtain proof of citizenship, please visit the <u>Department of Home Affairs website</u>.

A range of Notarial services are provided by appointment including authenticating and certifying documents, witnessing signatures, taking of statutory declarations, affidavits, oaths and affirmations, and other services. Fees apply and more information is available at our <u>website</u>.

NEW TO TEXAS?

HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



Moving to a new city can be a daunting task, especially when you are also relocating to a new country. To help with your transition, we have compiled a list of the most common tasks new arrivals encounter.

Driving - Texas requires residents to obtain a Texas Driver's License within three months of their arrival. We recommend using the "Get in Line" website to schedule your visit to the DPS as wait times can be long if you walk in without an appointment. You can find the latest info <u>HERE</u>.

Real Estate - Find a good realtor who understands your needs, and those of your family. Houston is a large city, with multiple freeways and traffic congestion, so it's important to consider daily commutes, school options and lifestyle.

Schools - Houston has some of the best school districts in the nation. Public school education is free - covered by local real estate property taxes. You will want to choose where to live wisely as public schools are zoned by neighborhood. There are also great private schools to choose from. A comprehensive list of school options can be found <u>HERE</u>.

Banking - Most US banks, lenders and insurance providers rely on a person's credit history to determine rates, loans and service options. Opening a US bank account and credit card can be beneficial in building US credit history. Consult with your bank to find out what is involved.

Australian Immigration - Houston has an Australian Consulate office in the Galleria area. The office is a great resource for Australians who need visa, passport or consular services. You can find their contact details <u>HERE</u>.

Whether you want to improve your business network, learn more about the opportunities for trade and investment between the US and Australia or you're looking for an excuse to have fun with Australians and Americans, the Australian American Chamber of Commerce provides members at both corporate and individual levels with many opportunities throughout the year to network and improve business and social links between the US and Australia.



Where innovative businesses thrive

Adelaide is the most affordable mainland Australian capital city to live in, rated as almost half as expensive as Sydney and about 20 per cent lower than Melbourne.

The 2023 Cost of Living Comparison conducted by Finder reveals Adelaide and Hobart are on par when it comes to overall household expenses that include housing, utilities, food and transport.

Sydney is 43 per cent more expensive and living costs in Melbourne are 22 per cent higher, while Perth (13 per cent) and Brisbane (12 per cent) also are significantly above Adelaide.

Business costs also are lower, as CBRE data reveal prime office space rents in Adelaide are 65 per cent lower than those of Sydney, at \$463 per square metre.

South Australia's Trade and Investment Minister, Nick Champion, says Australian Bureau of Statistics data show the state's private sector labour costs are almost 10 per cent below the national average.

"South Australia is a stable and low-risk destination for investment," he says. "If you're not here in South Australia, you're missing the boat.

"Our pro-business government, highly skilled workforce and enviable lifestyle makes South Australia one of the best places to live in the world."

Following the election of the new government, Invest SA was re-established to support businesses to take advantage of South Australia's competitive strengths and project them to the

South Australia is particularly embracing innovation, with four precincts established to better enable collaborative research and

development across Australia's industries of the future.

Adelaide BioMed City, located on North Terrace in the CBD, houses the largest concentration of clinical research in the southern hemisphere. Supporting world-leading medical services, the precinct provides true bench-to-bedside research and health treatment capability through links to the nearby Royal Adelaide Hospital.

Medical device research, meanwhile, is conducted at the Tonsley Innovation District, which is home to advanced manufacturing and the digitalisation of the manufacturing sector, otherwise known as the Fourth Industrial Revolution. The precinct combines research, development and training, and links business with Flinders University and TAFE SA.

At Mawson Lakes, Technology Park is home to more than 100 high-tech companies across defence and aerospace, health, training, engineering, advanced electronics and ICT. The park is located only 20 minutes north of the newest precinct, Lot Fourteen, where the space industry is the focus alongside defence, cybersecurity, machine learning, artificial intelligence and data analytics.

Invest SA executive director Christopher Wood says Lot Fourteen is home to the Australian Institute of Machine Learning, while an entrepreneurship focus has start-ups sitting alongside major global organisations.

"Global companies are tapping into South Australia's capabilities and are choosing to establish in South Australia," he says.

"Amazon Web Services has set up its artificial

intelligence team here and the Commonwealth Bank of Australia has its artificial intelligence, cybersecurity and data analytics teams here.

"Airbus, Microsoft Azure and Google Cloud have established or expanded within Adelaide's CBD to access these capabilities through partnerships and support from Invest SA."

Champion says South Australia is the defence state, with significant national research and development capability across both space and defence.

"South Australia's unique geography also supports international demand for sub-orbital and sun-synchronous launch," he says. "We are providing the world with a pathway to space."

South Australia remains the nation's wine hub, producing 80 per cent of Australia's premium wine. Safe, high-quality food is produced through the state's innovative agriculture industry, complemented by modern manufacturing and supported by research and technology.

The state has the largest agricultural research and education ecosystem in the southern hemisphere, while a new at-scale plant protein facility will mean SA leads the nation in responding to the rapidly expanding global demand for protein.

demand for protein. South Australia also remains at the forefront of mining the critical minerals the world needs, such as copper and nickel.

Powering business further is South Australia's record as one of the world's leading jurisdictions in generating renewable energy. National electricity market data reveal 70 per

National electricity market data reveal 70 per cent of the state's power was sourced from wind and solar in 2022 – more than double the proportion of its nearest state rivals of Western Australia and Victoria, each at 35 per cent.

Globally, the next highest jurisdiction is Denmark, where about 50 per cent of power is generated by wind and solar.

Champion says the state has been referred to as "being from the future", particularly as it is already meeting many bold and landmark renewable energy targets being set by governments around the world.

But it continues to go beyond, with the world's largest hydrogen production facility now in development. Already, South Australia is home to the world's first big battery.

SA aims to generate 100 per cent renewable energy by the end of this decade, then 500 per cent by 2050.
